

MAKE A BIRD MASK

You will need access to a printer, white card/thick paper, 4 sheets of coloured paper/card, colouring pencils/pens/crayons, a glue stick, sellotape and a stick.



1. Print out the bird mask sheet onto a piece of white card or thick paper.



2. Carefully cut out the bird mask, beak and feather template.



3. Using 4 different coloured sheets of card/paper, folded in half then half again, draw around the feather template within the space available then cut out feathers for the mask.



4. Layer the first coloured feathers within the middle section of the mask by gluing the lower half of each feather in order to create a 3d effect.



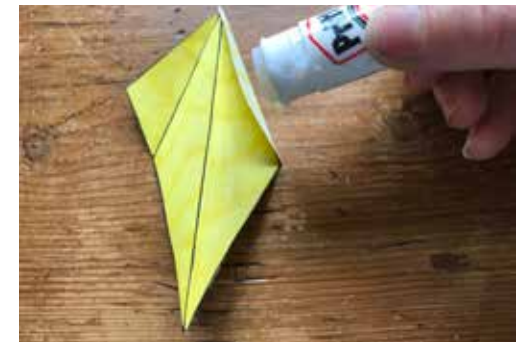
5. Once the middle section is completed begin to attach the first layer around the edge of the mask with the next set of coloured feathers.



6. Continue the second layer with a different set of coloured feathers.



7. Then with the remaining coloured feathers glue a final layer around the eyes of the mask.



8. Colour in the beak, fold along each of the lines and apply glue to the back of the two side triangular areas.



9. Attach the glued areas to the mask within the diagonal lines.



10. Sellotape a stick to the back of the mask.



11. The bird mask is now complete.
